

COUNTY COUNCIL OF TALBOT COUNTY

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ADMINISTRATIVE RESOLUTION AMENDING THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE SENIOR CITIZENS TASK FORCE TO INCLUDE TWO MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC

WHEREAS, on August 12, 2025, the County Council of Talbot County, Maryland (the "County Council") adopted an Amended Administrative Resolution (the "August 12th Administrative Resolution") for the purpose of establishing a Senior Citizens Task Force (the "Task Force"); and

WHEREAS, Section 2 of the August 12th Administrative Resolution sets forth the membership of the Task Force, which is comprised of representatives from the public and private sectors as well as nonprofit organizations; and

WHEREAS, the County Council is desirous of amending the membership of the Task Force to include two citizen representatives, as more fully set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of Talbot County, Maryland, that:

- 1. Section 2 of the August 12th Administrative Resolution be and it is hereby amended to read as follows, with additions in bold, underlined font and deletions in strikethrough:
 - 2. The Task Force shall consist of the following individuals, who shall serve for the terms indicated below and, except as otherwise indicated, be entitled to vote on all matters before the Task Force:
 - a. An individual currently serving on the Talbot County Commission on Aging or another qualified representative recommended thereby;
 - b. An individual currently serving on the Board of Directors of Delmarva Community Services, Inc. or another qualified representative recommended thereby;
 - c. An individual currently serving on the Board of Directors of Talbot Interfaith Shelter or another qualified representative recommended thereby;
 - d. An individual currently serving on the Board of Directors of the Neighborhood Service Center or another qualified representative recommended thereby;

- e. An individual currently serving on the Board of Directors of Mid-Shore Behavioral Health or another qualified representative recommended thereby;
 - f. A representative of the Talbot County Health Department Senior Care Program;
 - g. A representative of the Talbot County Mobile Integrated Health Program;
 - h. A member of the Easton Town Council; and
 - i. A member of the County Council; and
- j. Two citizen representatives, who shall be residents of the County and at least 65 years of age.
- 2. All other sections of the August 12th Administrative Resolution not amended hereunder shall remain in full force and effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Administrative Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
