A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE TALBOT COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE WATER AND SEWER PLAN FOR THE PURPOSE OF ADDING OR MODIFYING THE TALBOT COUNTY CAPITAL PROJECT FOR FISCAL YEARS 2023 AND 2024 TO ADD A NEW CAPITAL PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$8.6 MILLION FOR THE PURPOSE OF REPLACING THE TOWN OF EASTON'S GLEBE WATER TREATMENT PLANT WITH UPGRADED TECHNOLOGY

A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE TALBOT COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE WATER AND SEWER PLAN TO ADD OR MODIFY THE TALBOT COUNTY CAPITAL PROJECT FOR FYS 2023 AND 2024 TO ADD A NEW CAPITAL PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$8.6 MILLION FOR THE PURPOSE OF REPLACING THE TOWN OF EASTON'S GLEBE WATER TREATMENT PLANT WITH UPGRADED TECHNOLOGY

WHEREAS, the Talbot County Comprehensive Water and Sewer Plan (the "CWSP") contains capital projects for water and sewer service in Talbot County, Maryland, (the "County"); and

WHEREAS, the County Council of Talbot County, (the "County Council") desires to amend the CWSP for the purpose of including the capital project identified by Easton Utilities for Fiscal Years 2023 and 2024 into Table 7 of the CWSP, entitled "Easton Water System Capital Improvement Projects;" and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the requirements of Md. Code Ann., Envir. § 9-506(a)(1)(i), the proposed CWSP amendment set forth herein has been submitted to the Talbot County Planning Commission (the "Planning Commission"), as well as to the Talbot County Public Works Advisory Board, for review for consistency with planning programs for the area; and

WHEREAS, on _____, 2022, the Planning Commission certified that the proposed CWSP amendment set forth herein is consistent with the Comprehensive Plan as required by Md. Code Ann., Envir. 506(a)(1)(ii);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF TALBOT COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Talbot County Comprehensive Water and Sewer Plan shall be and is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION ONE: The above recitals are hereby incorporated as if fully set forth herein.

SECTION TWO: This project will replace the Town of Easton Glebe Water Treatment Plant with a new water treatment plant with upgraded technology. The proposed plant will improve drinking water quality for the Town of Easton and will increase the reliability and resiliency of the drinking water system.

SECTION THREE: The proposed Town of Easton Glebe Water Treatment Plant is currently in the schematic design phase, with GHD, Inc. having completed the design report on October 5, 2021.

SECTION FOUR: The proposed Town of Easton Glebe Water Treatment Plant serves 1,632 commercial properties and 6,877 residential properties, with an estimated 9,000 equivalent dwelling units (EDUs) being served by this water treatment plant.

SECTION FIVE: The engineering estimate to complete this project is \$8.6 million.

SECTION SIX: On January 31, 2022, the County submitted an application to the Maryland Department of the Environment (“MDE”) seeking grant and loan funds for this capital project.

SECTION SEVEN: Table 7 of the CWSP, entitled “Easton Water System Capital Improvement Projects,” shall be amended as follows:
